This will confirm our recent telephone conference which we had after I reviewed the letter to Clyde Bedell from Tom, dated May 22, 1978. I studied the letter quite carefully and checked the various pages in the Concordex mentioned therein, and it appears to me that the letter is quite satisfactory and in a conciliatory tone, which it should be.

Although there was no strong statement made to the effect that if he did not comply with your wishes you would withhold permission to quote from The URANTIA Book, I think that if he reads the letter carefully it is certainly inferred in the next to the last paragraph on the last page where it is indicated that the Trustees will consider the appropriateness of the inclusion of certain quotations, which you have heretofore given permission to use, in any further printings, re-printings or editions of the Concordex.

I have no suggestions for any further changes or modifications.
